The big news for 1981 is that the standard LTD powerteam is the 5.0 liter (302 CID) V-8 engine with Automatic Overdrive transmission for improved highway fuel economy.* In addition, LTD wagons offer these standard features: front and rear bumper guards, removable color-keyed load floor carpet, P-metric steel-belted WSW tires, and more.

Whether you choose the LTD or the elegant Country Squire, you can enjoy the same Ford Wagonmaster innovations, including: 3-Way Magic Doorgate with power window, one-hand fold-down second seat, and optional dual-facing rear seats which increase LTD's 6-passenger capacity to eight (including removable seat cushions).

LTD wagons also offer a wide range of options. Heavy-Duty Trailer Towing Package, 5.8 liter high-output engine, wide range of seating selections, exclusive DuraWeave vinyl trim, Autolamp On/Off/Delay System, Illuminated Entry System, Traction-Lok Axle and Premium Sound System, to name just a few.



LTD's 3-Way Magic Doorgate


A Wagonmaster first. Opens out like a door (with power window up or down) or drops down like a tailgate.

LTD's Dual Facing Rear Seats

This better idea option is available on LTD. It increases LTD's 6-passenger capacity to eight. Seat cushions are removable for additional under-floor stowage space.

LTD Cargo Space

A big 89.5 cu. ft. with rear seat down. And wide enough to accommodate 4 x 8-ft. sheets of plywood flat on the cargo floor (doorgate lowered). There's an extra 9.9 cu. ft. below the floor and two more cubic feet in a side stowage compartment, both lockable!






LTD Lockable Side Stowage Compartment



Escort Front Wheel Drive/Independent Suspension

We're America's Wagonmaster. And our aim right now is to build wagons that meet the challenges of the 80's. Fairmont is trimmer than previous mid-size wagons. Retained, though, are ample roominess for passengers and lots of space for cargo.

From the first, Fairmont's cargo capacity has been unbeaten among mid-size wagons built in America, with an impressive 79.5 cu. ft.


