MUSTANG GT

o survive in the world of automobiles, you need to be strong. You need to provide what the driving public demands or you won't last very long. After 25 years, Mustang is not only still around, but is as strong and as popular as ever.

Mustang GT is one of the reasons. Bold, aggressive styling. The powerful 5.0L V-8 under the hood. Firm handling suspension. Fat, performance radials. It's a combination that begs to be driven.

The 5.0 liter V-8 puts out 225 horsepower at 4.200 rpm and 300 lb. ft. of torque at only 3.200 rpm.

Putting all that torque to good use is a Borg-Warner 5-speed with tifth gear overdrive and standard rear Traction-Lok axle. If you preter, order the convenience of the optional 4-speed Automatic Overdrive transmission.

The handling suspension system uses nitrogen gas-pressurized hydraulic struts in tront with Ford's Quadra-Shock system in the rear and progressive rate coil springs at all corners.

GTs long list of standard performance features is quite impressive. You can find out more about them on pages 10-11. After 25 years, Mustang is not only still around, but is as strong and popular as ever.

GT's aggressive stance is due in part to its "ground effects" styling. The low-profile hood, front and rear fascias, front air dam, integrated fender extensions with scoops, and rear decklid spoiler all contribute to GT's bold look.

This year, you can select the option of rich leather seating surtaces for the GT interior. The front articulated bucket seats offer power adjustable lumbar supports, manually adjustable side bolsters and under-thigh supports, plus reclining seat backs.

Easily seen through the leatherwrapped steering wheel, are a full complement of analog gauges including a 7,000 rpm tach, voltmeter, temperature and oil pressure gauges. The brake and accelerator pedals are positioned to allow heel-and-toe downshifting and there is a left side foot rest/ support for the driver.

MUSTANG LX 5.0L

estrained excitement. That would be one way to describe the Mustang LX 5.0L. Introduced in 1989, the LX 5.0L was an immediate success. And with good reason. With the LX 5.0L you get the smooth, clean styling of the Mustang LX model, plus all of the performance attributes of the GT. And it's available in 2-door hatchback, 2-door sedan and convertible models.

Under the hood is the powerful 5.0L V-8 putting out 225 horsepower and 300 lb. ft. of torque.

The handling suspension system is the same as that used for the GT. Nitrogen gas-pressurized hydrau-

lic front struts and rear Quadra-Shock set-up for that performance ride. Progressive-rate coil springs at the corners. Quick 14.7:1 constant ratio steering, Traction-Lok axle, P225/ 60VRx15 performance tires and 10-hole cast aluminum wheels.

Inside the hatchback and convertible models are the articulated, multi-adjustable front bucket seats (available this year with optional Titanium leather seating surfaces), brake and accelerator pedals that are positioned to allow heel-and-toe downshifting, soft-feel steering wheel and electronic AM/FM stereo.

Convertible models are a big part of Mustang fun. Just lower the power retractable top and experience the driving freedom that only a convertible can give.

FORD MUSTANG LX

Mustang's personality remains unchanged. Simply put, Mustang in its purest form is just plain fun to drive.

The standard LX, featured on these two pages, is a perfect example of that personality. It's powered by a responsive 2.3 liter overhead cam 4-cylinder engine with electronically controlled multiple-port fuel injection. The manual transmission adds to the fun with five forward speeds (fifth gear overdrive).

And LX is well equipped, too. Power rack-and-pinion steering and power front disc/rear drum brakes are standard.

Inside are reclining low back bucket seats and center console. Full analog instrumentation is also

standard along with an electronic AM/FM stereo search radio with four speakers. For a more complete look at Mustang LX major standard features, see the chart on page 13.

New for 1990 in all Mustang models is the standard Driver's Side Air Bag Supplemental Restraint System, or SRS. When used in conjunction with the 3-point safety belts, it provides an extra measure of protection for the driver.

Hatchback models feature a split/fold rear seat and fully carpeted cargo area with a window shade-type cover. The split/fold design rear seat gives versatility in the cargo area as well as access to 30 cubic feet of space (both seat backs down).


Mustang LX is also available in

a convertible model. It comes complete with a power retractable top and rear glass fold down window. Convertibles also have a few other standard features over the other bodystyles. Such as power side windows (including the rear quarter windows), dual electric remote-control mirrors, power lock group, and more.

MUSTANG SPECIAL VALUE PROGRAM

The Mustang Special Value option is what some might call, "...an offer you can't refuse."

With it you can get the power lock group, dual electric remote control mirrors, electronic AM/FM stereo with cassette player, speed control and power side windows—all at no additional charge.

MUSTANG INTERIOR

othing contributes more to the enjoyment of driving a Mustang than the sporty interior.

Mustang's front bucket seats are designed to be firm and supportive to help reduce fatigue. High density foam pads in the seat cushion and seat back side bolsters give a wraparound effect to help hold you in place. The front seat backs recline and the headrests are adjustable two-ways.

The rear bench seat provides room for two and in hatchback models it has a split-fold design.


In the performance-minded LX 5.0L (hatchback and convertible) and GT models, the articulated front bucket seats feature adjustable seat cushion side bolsters and a power adjustable lumbar support. There's also an adjustable under-thigh support.

The standard AM/FM stereo radio is electronically tuned and features four-speaker sound. Or, order the optional electronic AM/FM stereo with cassette tape player. Round that out with Premium Sound that adds an 80-watt power amplifier.

The analog gauges are large and easy to read. And there is a full complement: fuel, engine coolant temperature, voltmeter, oil pressure and tachometer.

DRIVER AIR BAG SUPPLEMENTAL RESTRAINT SYSTEM (SRS)

New for 1990 is a driver air bag supplemental restraint system as standard equipment.


The supplemental air bag, located in a module in the center of the steering wheel, is designed to activate in the event of a moderate to severe frontal impact roughly equivalent to striking a parked car of similar size at 28 miles per hour.

From initial impact to full deployment, the air bag inflates in less than 1/10 of a second. It also begins to deflate within a fraction of a second.

The supplemental air bag is designed for one use. Once used, the module must be removed and replaced by a qualified service technician. Replacement is normally covered by the insurance company as part of the collision repair. In addition, many insurance companies are offering discounts on the medical premiums for cars equipped with air bags.

It is very important to remember that the air bag is intended to supplement, not replace, the driver's conventional lap and shoulder belt. The safety belt system helps provide protection in all types of impacts. When used together, air bags and safety belts comprise one of the best occupant restraint systems available today.

Mustang GT interior shown in Titanium. Some equipment shown is optional.





riving. That's what Ford Mustang is all about. City streets or open road, Mustang responds to you. And each Mustang model is designed to respond in a slightly different

The LX achieves its ride characteristics with nitrogen gaspressurized hydraulic struts and stabilizer bar in front along with nitrogen gas-pressurized hydraulic shocks in the rear.

In the LX 5.0L and GT models, the suspensions are designed to match their higher performance capabilities. Some of those components are progressive rate springs and a larger stabilizer bar in front. In the rear is the Quadra-Shock system, incorporating two verticallymounted nitrogen gas-pressurized hydraulic shocks, two horizontallymounted hydraulic axle dampers and a stabilizer bar.

MUSTANG POWER

The 2.3L engine that powers Mustang LX models is a 4-cylinder in-line type with a single overhead cam and modified wedge combustion chambers. It features electronic multiple-port fuel injection and electronic engine control through the EEC-IV computer.


In GT and the LX 5.0L, the highoutput V-8 is rated at 225 horsepower at 4,200 rpm. It also delivers 300 lb. ft. of torque at 3,200 rpm.

Some of the components used to reach those impressive figures are: SEFI; high performance inductionhardened camshaft; low friction roller tappets; double-roller timing chain; forged aluminum alloy pistons; tuned stainless steel tubular headers; large diameter dual exhausts and much more.

A standard 5-speed manual transmission with overdrive fifth gear lets you utilize all that power with the precision of direct linkage shifting.

Gear ratios for the 5-speed are: 1st gear-3.35; 2nd gear-1.93; 3rd gear-1.29; 4th gear-1.00; 5th gear-0.68.

The 5.0L engine has a proven overhead valve design with modified combustion chambers. The block and heads are cast iron and the intake manifold is aluminum. It uses forged aluminum alloy pistons for light weight and good heat dissipation. The connecting rods are forged steel for strength.

Next, take a look at the list of individual options included in the bottom of the chart. Individual options allow you to add a little or a lot depending on your needs.

Automatic Overdrive Transmission-manual transmissions are great-for some people-but if they're not for you, this option is a must. The Automatic Overdrive transmission is available on all Mustang models, even GT.

Flip-up Open-air Roof-if you like the feeling of the open air but are sold on the versatility of the hatchback model, you should consider this attractive alternative. Available on hatchbacks only, the flip-up glass panel is convenient and easy to use. It can be flipped up partially or removed completely.
