## Options? You want options? Here they are.

Everyone wants options these days. Given if it's the option of not wanting any options—because Dart models are equipped with an amazing number of standard equipment features.) People want options for a number of individual reasons. Most of all, to personalize their cars and make them particularly "theirs." So that you can move easily read about the many Dart options offered for 1968 and determine the ones you'd like to have added to your new Dart, we have arranged them in groupings:

*(Items shown, left, are top to bottom)*  
**Frontend, left—**  
Optional, wood-grained steering wheel with padded hub. Variable-speed wipers (D-pinned wipers, std.).

**2nd left column—**  
230-cubic-inch, 4-barrel, high-performance V8 (GTS only). Power brakes and disc brakes (optional, all Dart models). Custom color-keyed head restraints (optional, all models).

**3rd left column—**  
Wheel covers (std., GT; optional other Dart models). Dart air conditioning, radio. Dart bumper guards (front and rear). Immediate left—

Remote-control outside mirror (manual mirror, std.). Header-mounted turn signal indicators (optional, all models). Power bulge on hood is std. on GTS models). Vinyl roof (available in black, enameled green, enameled white). (Dart 4-dr. sedans, hardtops).

**Comfort and Convenience**  
Air conditioning (with all engines except 170 Six and 383 V8). Head window defogger (except on convertibles). AM radio. Tachometer (V8 models equipped with center console only). Power steering. Power brakes.

Center console (GT, GTS w/buckets). Right, outside mirror. Left, outside, remote-control mirror. Tinted windshield and windows. Hood insulation. Undercarriage.

Custom color-keyed head restraints, front seats, left and right. Front and rear center seat belts. Front seat shoulder belts, left and right. Rear seat shoulder belt, left and right. Variable-speed wipers/electric washer. Front seat-cushion pads, 2½" form. All-vinyl interior.

(This is standard on modern coupes like the Dart 230 4-door, which has cloth upholstery interior. If you want Dart 230 4-door with all-vinyl interior, it's available, at an accent.)

### Dodge Dart Light Package

Trunk compartment light. Glove box light. Ashtray light. Time-delay, ignition switch light. (This automatically turns the lights on when you open the door and off when the car doors are closed. It lets you find the ignition switch in the dark without switching on the interior lights. Map and courtesy light.\*

\*Three less items are standard on Dart convertibles, but a part of the optional Light Package on other Dart models.

### Performance

225 cubic-inch Six. (170-cu.-in. Six is standard) 318 cubic-inch V8. (230-cu.-in. V8 is standard) 361-cubic-inch V8 (GTS only)—340-cu.-in. V8, std.) Torque-Flite 3-speed automatic transmission (std. on GTS with 240 V8; 4-on-the-floor (manual transmission) (available with V8 engines only; not with Sixes).

10.1-lb. fast manual steering (24:1, a little slower steering ratio, in standard). Front disc brakes (14" wheels and tires are included). Rallye Suspension (standard on Dart GTS models, optional on

others) includes: heavy-duty torsion bars, heavy-duty ball joints, heavy-duty rear springs (5 leaves), sway bar.

Heavy-duty shock absorbers (std. on GTS, opt. other Dart models) E10x 14. Red Stripes (std. (standard on GTS, optional on others))

5.5J wide-rim wheels (furnished with the E10x 14 tires). Trailer-Towing Package (Details are listed with specifications on back cover.)

### Appearance

Silver Metallic exterior enamel. (All other colors are standard). Two-tone paint (sedans and hardtops only, not convertibles). Racing stripes (body sides) for GTS. (They're standard, but you have several "private" options on these models.)

Bumblebee stripe (across the rear deck) for GTS. (You can have this instead of the racing stripes along the side. No extra cost. They come in red, black or white.) No stripes for GTs.

Vinyl roof covering (210 Series sedans, all hardtop models). (choice of three colors: black, antique white, antique green). Deluxe wheel covers (standard on GT models, optional on others, but not available on GTS).

Deluxe 14" wheel covers (on models equipped with optional 14" wheels and tires). Deluxe deep-dish simulated "mag" wheel covers (These require the 6.6J wide-rim wheels). Front and rear bumper guards. Side molding (optional on all models except GT Sedan). Fender-mounted turn signal indicators (optional, all models). Exterior dress-up moldings (4-door sedans only).

3-spoke steering wheel with full horn ring, padded hub (opt. all models). 3-spoke wood-grained steering wheel (opt. 230 GT and GTS models).

## GTS

This is the top of the Dart line for 1968. Definitely a performance-oriented car that offers engines that are available on GTS and on no other Dodge model. Standard GTS equipment includes: 340 (4-bbl.) V8 engine, Torqueflite 3-speed automatic transmission, Rallye Suspension, 14 x 5.5 wheels, E90 110 Red Stripe wide oval tires, heavy-duty shock absorbers, "power bulge" in the hood, racing stripes or "bullet-hole" stripes; and an engine dress-up kit. And, with the exception of wheel covers (GTS features), the remainder of the standard equipment list is similar to Dart G1 models.

GTS convertibles have full-width bench seats; all-vinyl (bucket seats are optional). GTS hardtops have bucket seats, standard. Both types of interiors are available in: blue, red, black, or white/black. In addition, interiors with buckets are available in: green, gold, white/blue, white/green, or white/gold.

## GT

GT models are the most luxurious, offering the most complete list of standard and optional equipment in the Dart line for '68. Standard GT equipment includes: 170 Slant Six or 273 V8 engine, 3-speed manual column shift, heater/defraser, cigarette lighter,\* power top for convertible,\* a choice of 16 exterior colors,\* 16-gallon fuel tank,\* self-adjusting brakes,\* spare tire storage in firewall beneath luggage compartment floor, Cleaner Air System,\* full carpeting,\* 3-spoke steering wheel with padded hub and partial horn ring,\* and full wheel covers.

GT convertibles have full-width bench seats; all-vinyl (bucket seats are optional). GT hardtops have bucket seats, standard. Both types of interiors are available in: blue, red, black, or white/black. In addition, interiors with buckets are available in: green, gold, white/blue, white/green, or white/gold.

\*These starred items are included as standard equipment on GTS models, too.

## COLORS

A choice of 16 standard (and 1 optional) over-blended, acrylic enamel colors is offered on all 1968 Dart models. In addition, two-tone paint is offered, optional, in many combinations, on sedans and hardtops; and vinyl roof covering in dark green, black or white is optional on Dart 270 sedans and all Dart hardtops.



## 270

People who want a lot of car for their money but don't want to spend a lot of money on their car will find a great deal in their share in the new Dart 270 models for 1968. Standard 270 Series equipment includes: 170 Slant Six or 273 V8 engine, 3-speed manual column shift, heater/defraser, cigarette lighter, a choice of 16 exterior colors, 16-gallon fuel tank, nickel-plated bumpers, spare tire storage in firewall beneath luggage compartment floor, Cleaner Air System, full carpeting, 3-spoke steering wheel with padded hub and partial horn ring.

Dart 270 hardtops have full-width bench seats; all-vinyl, with interiors available in: blue, green, tan, red, black, white/black, white/tan, or white/red. Dart 270 4-door sedans have full-width bench seats, cloth-and-vinyl. Interiors are offered in: blue, green, or tan. In addition, an optional all-vinyl interior is available for Dart 270 sedans in: blue, tan, red, or black.



## DART

Dart Series models for '68 are the lowest-priced Dodges of all! Surely can you find this kind of room, comfort and convenience in this Series' price range. Standard equipment includes: all Dart 270 items with the exception of cigarette lighter, carpeting, and partial horn ring.

Dart Series sedans (both 2-door and 4-door) have full-width bench seats, available in a choice of: blue, tan, or black.

#### SUSPENSION

All Dart models have lower bars and ball joints in front; coil-spring leaf springs in the rear. The Dart shock absorber at each wheel. The entire suspension is rubber-mounted. The Dart Safety Suspension and heavy-duty shock absorbers (described on the optional equipment page) are standard on GTS models, optional on some Dart models.

#### BRAKES

Front (front/rear)...9" x 2.5" (9" x 2.6" Disc Brake System). Hydraulic, self-adjusting, self-energizing. Rear (front). Parking brake is hand-operated, hand-assisted—mechanically assisting when set with rear wheel. Space brakes are optional on all Dart models. Front disc brakes (14" wheels and tires are included) are also optional on all Dart models.

#### TIRES

5-cyl. models...6.50 x 12 (170-Six only)  
6.50 x 12 (240-V8, 225-D) 7.00 x 12 (240-V8, 225-D)  
V8 (except 225-D)...7.00 x 12 (240-V8, 225-D)

14" wheels and tires are optional on all Dart models, except Dart STS models on which they are standard. 170x14 Red Streak tires mounted on 14 x 5.5" wide-walls, wheels, require the addition of the optional Roll-a-Suspension tire items—standard, STS model.

\*MSR=Minimum tire size required (body code). Also 8.00 x 14 optional on all except GTS. EXN 14 white sidewall is no charge option on GTS, extra cost on other models. 7.00 x 14 white or black sidewall optional on Dart, Dart 200 and Dart GT.

#### ELECTRICAL SYSTEM

Battery: 12-volt, 6-cell, 38-amp hr, standard, on 5-cylinder models; 48-amp hr, standard, on V8 models. Headlight-applied on all Dart models. Alternator: 60 amp. Standard on 5-cylinder models. 55 amp optional on 225-D. Headlight: 12-volt, 40-watt, supplied by Dodge. Alternator: 60 amp with 6.0 or V8 and standard with air conditioning on V8 models.

#### TRANSMISSIONS

Three basic transmissions are offered on 1968 Dodge Dart models.

SHF lever. It is standard with the 170-Six, 225-D, and 225-V8 only, and not available on GTS models.

The 3-speed manual has a floor-mounted shift, for convenience, in Dart models equipped with optional center console. The 4-speed manual is optional with Dart V8 engines, and is not available in 5-cylinder models.

The 4-speed automatic is also available with the 170-Six, a column-mounted shift, not floor-mounted. In Dart models equipped with optional center console, it is water-cooled, has an automatic housing, and an internally actuated parking soap. A "Central Shifter" (Dual gear feature) gives improved acceleration and economy for 6-cylinder Dart models. Torque-flite automatic is standard on 170-Six models with the 225-V8 engine, optional on other Dart models—standard and ves-

selizer, 10"-diameter brakes (standard with V8 engines). Wide hub wheels (ESK) are optional.

Traction-Lowering Package is available on Dart models powered by 225-Six or 225-V8 only.

The following extra-cost equipment is also required: Traction-Lowering Package, 170-Six wide-cut tires.

Recommended additional optional equipment for trailer towing: Power steering, power brakes. Some GM oil filters, high-pressure, 40-amp alternator, 70-amp GM heavy-duty battery, GM rubber corporates and heat shield. Air conditioning, 200-cubic-inch V8 engine. Front disc brakes.

#### All Dart models include these items as standard safety equipment.

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The nicest thing about Dodge Fever is our engine and drive train warranty.

Chrysler Corporation warrants to the first and second registered owners of Dodge vehicles, headlight, interval ports, intake, master, motor, water pump, transmission case and internal parts (except manual clutch), torque converter, driveshaft, universal joint, rear axle and differential, suspension system (except shock absorbers), steering gear and linkage system, wheels and wheel bearings of its 1968 automobiles for 5 years or 50,000 miles, whichever occurs first, and to the third registered owner for 24 months or 30,000 miles, whichever occurs first, against defects in materials and workmanship and will repair or replace such defective parts without charge for parts or labor at any Dodge or Imperial, Chrysler or Plymouth Authorized Dealer's place of business. Maintenance such as replacement of spark plugs, carburetors, ignition points, filters, brake and clutch lining, etc., and normal wear and tear, as well as wear and tear to upholstery, soft trim and appearance items are not included. Maintenance services required under warranty are: Orange engine oil, every 3 months or 4,000 miles, whichever occurs first, and replace oil filter every 30,000 miles; orange oil, every 8 months or 8,000 miles, whichever occurs first; and replace oil filter every 12 months.

(A) There is an additional Imperial, Chrysler, Plymouth or Dodge Dealer's warranty on an approved Warranty Validation form for the original owner of the vehicle for 5 years or 50,000 miles, whichever occurs first, and (B) the original owner must submit such completed forms to Chrysler Motors Corporation. To qualify for continuing warranty coverage, the second registered owner must have an authorized Dodge or Imperial, Chrysler or Plymouth Dealer submit a Transfer of Warranty form to Chrysler Motors Corporation within 30 days from the date of purchase, and receive from Chrysler Motors Corporation an letter that the vehicle is eligible for such coverage.
