



The Custom 500 Ranch Wagon and Custom Ranch Wagon are for value seekers who want a big wagon at a down-to-earth price. These are fullsized wagons with all of Ford's better idea wagon features. Wheelbase is 121 inches. Track is 63 inches (rear, 64). Stance is solid and stable. The ride is super-quiet and sedan-like.

In addition to the standard six-passenger model, the Custom 500 Ranch Wagon is offered in an eight-passenger version with dual-facing rear seats. All models have a lockable, below-deck storage compartment. All have Ford's 3-Way Magic Doorgate. And all have the big 351cu. in. V-8 standard. Other standard features include the new Locking Steering Column, and the new Uni-Lock Safety Harness with automatic seat belt adjustment and single buckle for both seat and shoulder belts. The Squire has a new standard engine, the 302 CID V-8. In the Torino Wagon the 250 CID Six is standard. V-8 options are offered up to 429 CID . . twice-a-year maintenance

1970 Fords, Torinos and Falcons are designed to go 6,000 miles (or 6 months) between oil changes and minor chassis lubrications; 36,000 miles (or 3 years, whichever comes first) between major chassis lubes. Other '70 service-savers include 24,000-mile (or 2-year) engine coolant-antifreeze, self-adjusting brakes, long-life Sta-Ful battery, shielded alternator, rust- and corrosion-resistant aluminized muffler and galvanized major underbody parts. Ford Wagons need so little service, it's wise to see they get the best—at your Ford Dealer's.

NOTE: Your new 1970 Ford Wagons come equipped with factory engineered and approved parts such as the dependable Autolite Sta-Ful battery, Autolite Power-Tip spark plugs, Autolite shock absorbers, and an Autolite 6000-mile oil filter. For continued top performance, be sure to specify genuine Autolite parts whenever replacement is necessary.
