You can tell a lot about a New Yorker just by looking at it. It's obviously a big car—and that goes for both size and comfort. And it's obviously a luxury car—one look at its standard interior appointments and exterior styling tells you that.

The front end has been restyled. There's a new grille. And the security of an extra-protection bumper system, front and rear.

What you can't see are some of the Chrysler engineering innovations. Things like an Electronic Ignition System that helps your ignition stay in tune longer than conventional systems and it is virtually maintenance-free. Improved starting through the use of a new high-speed starting motor. Strength from a Unibody that's welded together with over 4,000 welds.

Something you won't be aware of in a quiet New Yorker is noise. Rubber isolators help reduce the noise and vibration of the road, keeping it outside the passenger compartment. We've also improved the sealing along the windows, pillars, and rear window defogger openings. Furthermore, additional sound-deadening materials have been added to the rear pillar and adjacent roof. And through the use of an improved muffler with three metal wraps and laminated exhaust pipes, the noise level is kept down.

Chrysler makes only one station wagon. It's enough. We think it is the best choice among luxury wagons. And there's also a choice of Town & Country models: you can have a 2- or 3-seat version.

Some of the standard equipment items in a Town & Country include a 440 cubic inch, four-barrel V-8, TorqueFlite automatic transmission, power steering, power front disc brakes, Torsion-Quiet Ride, electric clock, and the Electronic Ignition System.

Some of the station wagon features include: simulated wood-grain along the body sides and the tailgate, a three-way tailgate, roof air deflector, power tailgate window, concealed storage compartment and a power Auto-Lock that automatically locks the tailgate when the ignition is on.




Chrysler has always been proud of its reputation for engineering innovations . . . as well as retaining and refining the best of its past discoveries.

The components of this handling and comfort package include front torsion bars that twist to help rid the car of road shock. Unibody construction to make the car body tough and strong. And rubber sound-deadening materials to help ensure your Chrysler has a quieter passenger compartment than ever before. There's even a redesigned muffler with three metal wraps that helps keep noise to a minimum.

In the area of electronic ad- vancements, Chrysler has been a leader for many years. For more reliable operation, our electronic voltage regulator has proven itself in the field. So has our Electronic Ignition System which is now standard on all Chryslers. This system eliminates the need for breaker points — a common cause of increased emissions due to engine misfiring-and the condenser. Excluding spark plugs, the system is essentially maintenance-free. Your original engine timing should be good for 50,000 miles or more.

And due to its higher voltage, electronic ignition plus our highspeed starting motor makes starting easier in cold weather. Even at below zero temperatures.

Chrysler space-age technology now brings you two new electronic marvels. The first is an optional digital clock. This electronic clock, expected to be the first of its kind for the industry, provides you with a numerical readout, rather than indicating time on a dial.

Accuracy will be within the range of plus or minus one minute a month.

Another new electronic option is our Security Alarm System. This system, unlike some other systems, is integrated right into the car's wiring harness. The system is armed by locking either front door with the ignition-door key. Once the system is armed, it can only be turned off by using the key. If someone attempts to disturb the hood, trunk (tailgate), doors, or ignition, the alarm is activated. This alarm starts the headlights, taillights, and side marker lights flashing in conjunction with the horn blowing intermittently. For your convenience, entrance to the trunk (or tailgate) with the key can be made without violating the system. Optional power door locks are required.

Other new developments for all 1973 Chrysler automobiles include an extra-protection bumper system that exceeds the federal government's new damage standards for low-speed accidents. It's capable of withstanding head-on barrier impact forces of 5 mph in the front and 2½ mph in the rear with no significant damage to the body of the car... or to safety-related items like latches, lights, exhaust and fuel systems... or to the bumper system itself.

Other new options for '73 include that "old" favorite, vent windows (available on all 4-door models), and steel-belted, radial-ply whitewall tires for longer tread life (available all models).

We are also committed to protecting the environment. Our Cleaner Air System, a highly integrated emission control system, has evolved through the years to effectively reduce the level of emissions.


One of the nice advantages about owning a Chrysler is the performance and economy you can enjoy. That's right . . . economy.

With either of our engines (including the 440 cubic inch V-8, the largest ever produced by us), you'll enjoy the power without having to pay a premium gas price. And whether you have a Chrysler equipped with a 440 or a 400 V-8 engine, you'll have enough power to pass, handle freeway driving, and to tow a trailer.

Our engines with optional air conditioning or with heavy-duty and trailer-towing packages now feature a coolant overflow reservoir that serves several purposes: prevents coolant loss during heavy load applications . . . for storage of additional coolant reserve . . . as a convenient means for visually checking the coolant level . . . and for adding coolant when needed. A tube from the radiator to the reservoir allows any overflow coolant to be directed into the reservoir. After the engine has cooled sufficiently, any overflow coolant in the reservoir automatically will flow back into the radiator.

Every Chrysler also comes through with unibody construction, front torsion-bar suspension and multileaf rear springs. Plus power steering, power front disc brakes, Electronic Ignition System and TorqueFlite automatic transmission.

Our TorqueFlite transmission has been improved through the addition of a hydrodynamic front pump seal that increases reliability. Also, a more flexible kickdown band is used to provide more consistent shifting. And a new design increases the life of the over-running clutch.

In addition, our TorqueFlite comes with a new transmission fluid filter that has a 50% increase in filtering area to improve the life of both fluid and transmission.

One of the most noticeable things about a Chrysler is the room you get. Rear seat passengers will especially appreciate the ample knee room. We feel you and your passengers will never feel cramped in a Chrysler. Last year, according to the Automotive Industries' roominess index, Chrysler had the largest interior of any car. This year we expect to retain our interior leadership. Our seats measure 57.2 inches wide. And they are foam-padded and contoured to assure comfort.

They are luxurious, too. With a great selection of colors, fabrics and vinyls. Body-cradling bucket seats. Bench seats with fold-down center armrests. Or the flexibility and luxury of a 50/50 divided bench seat with individual adjustments and passenger side recliner. Optional power seats are also available.

Standard tires are durable biasbelted black sidewall tires. Optional tires include bias-belted and steelbelted radial whitewalls. Radial tires offer smooth high-speed ride characteristics and improved tread life. They carry a 40,000 mile tread life expectancy policy.

Another nice money-saving feature about a Chrysler is that the chassis only needs lubrication after 36,000 miles.

And speaking about money, many people think of a Chrysler as being unaffordable. It isn't so. Our model lineup consists of 13 cars. Each and every one is a Chrysler. Some of them are priced right around what you would pay for many of the most popular smaller cars, comparably equipped.


