## AND TODAY:

In 1973, Dodge comes on strong with a host of meaningful engineering advance-

ments. The Electronic Ignition System is standard on all Dodge six-cylinder and V8 engines this year. With no points to wear out and no condenser to replace, this system reduces the frequency of resetting ignition timing under normal conditions. By eliminating the major cause of misfiring, it also reduces resultant engine emissions. A new highspeed starter for improved starting is standard this year on models with the 360, 400, or 440 V8 engine.

## **CLEANER AIR, ANYONE?**

The list of new and improved emission control features on the 1973 Dodge engines is an imposing one. Dodge's Cleaner Air System (CAS), developed over the years, effectively reduces the levels of hydrocarbons, carbon monoxide, and oxides of nitrogen. Other new and worthwhile advances in Dodge's quest for cleaner air include the electric assist choke . . . the exhaust gas

recirculation system (EGR) . . . proportional exhaust gas recirculation (PEGR) . . . and the orifice spark advance control (OSAC). These items are all standard on all Dodge engines for 1973.

## NOW HEAR THIS.

An electronic Security Alarm System is available on all '73 Monacos and Polaras. Tampering with the hood, doors, or trunk lid causes the headlights, taillights, and side marker lights to flash in conjunction with a pulsing of the horn. The alarm continues as long as the violation exists or until shut off with the ignition-door key. It then rearms itself automatically. The system is camouflaged and is built into your car's regular wiring system to thwart tampering.

## SILENCE, PLEASE.

All 1973 Dodges offer major chassis and interior improvements to reduce interior noise levels. What's more, Charger and Coronet now offer Dodge's famous Torsion-Quiet Ride. This is a sophisticated suspension system which helps isolate the passenger compartment from road and engine noises through the use of strategically located rubber mounts, extra padding, and other insulation materials. Charger SE goes a step further with a premium silencing package that indeed makes it a super quiet car.
