FURY CUSTOM

Fury's styling changes include a number of fresh new colors. The 18 shades offered for '75 are each formulated to match the spirit of the new small Fury. Also, you can choose among 6 vinyl tops in white, parchment, black, gold, green and red. Each is selected to coordinate with your chosen body color.

The new chrome grille is set into a new fiberglass front panel giving an overall feeling of smoothly integrated design. There is also plenty of glass area and more satisfying vision.

Equally satisfying is the degree of quiet you can expect from these two

quality-built Furys. A number of components contribute to Fury's comfortable performance. Rubber mounts are used to isolate the front suspension cross member from direct body contact. Rubber clamps around the rear leaf springs help reduce road noise reverberation. The steering wheel is designed with a double coupling to cut down on vibration. And we've come up with strategically placed sound deadeners and sealers to minimize wind noise.


In keeping with the smaller-butluxurious theme, such desirable options as sun roof, stylish road

You have three smart interiors to choose from in the Fury Sport. A well-tailored pleated vinyl, deeply contoured bucket seat is standard. And you get a choice of red, blue, green, black or gold to match your preferred exterior color. Plus white mixed with the same colors for variety. Additionally, there is our striking Boca Raton cloth-and-vinyl bench seat, an optional choice that comes in six equally smart colors. Also available is the cloth-and-vinyl bucket seat in gold, black and white.

We've reserved some tasteful seat combinations for the Fury Custom 2-Door Hardtop, too. Cloth-and-vinyl in 6 rich colors is standard. But you can choose an all-vinyl bench design with folding center armrest or the eye-opening Sundance cloth-andvinyl with color-keyed shag carpet all 'round.

Both the Sport and Custom provide standard carpeting, the former a shag material, the latter, deep-pile. You also get a three-spoke steering wheel and instrument panel thoughtfully planned for safe, convenient use. In keeping with the Fury Sport's basic character, all instrumentation is housed in circular dials with white-onblack numerals for easy, accurate viewing.

A long list of power options is available to those who prefer even greater convenience. Power front disc brakes, power steering, power windows and power seats are recommended for the power-oriented buyer. Auto Speed Control is another highly regarded option which can save you fuel by automatically holding your Fury's speed constant whenever you feel the occasion demands.

There are also such options as a manually-operated sun roof and a selection of distinctive wheels and wheel covers you may want to choose.

Try the new small Fury at your dealer's. Look at it. Sit in it. Drive it. And discover how luxury has taken on new dimensions for 1975.

ROAD RUNNER

The others haven't caught up with it yet.

If you still want to get a kick out of a car, but still insist on plenty of luxury, Road Runner comes up with all the bright answers.

A long hood, a lower side body line for 1975 with a new chrome and black grille, up-and-over tape stripes keyed for use with a total of 18 colors, the Road Runner emblem on the rear deck lid, and rallye road wheels fitted with G70 x 14 raised white letter tires. Two other optional wheels are shown below, right.

The same youthful philosophy is just as apparent inside. All-vinyl bucket seats are standard and come in red, blue, green, black or gold. These colors also come with white trim. If you want, the same seat design is available in our highly original Sundance material. If you like a bench seat, you can get it in Sundance cloth, too. Color-coordinated carpeting is standard.

The instrument panel is a cluster design with readable gauges that'll get the approval of even the most diehard sports car buff. Space is reserved for an optional electric clock or tachometer and "low fuel" warning system—whichever you want to order. Our soft-rimmed "Tuff" steering wheel (shown in our illustration) is an option totally in tune with the spirit of the Road Runner image.

So much for looks. Now for Road Runner performance. Our husky, 318 V-8 is standard, though you can order the 360 or 400 cubic inch editions (the 400 2-bbl. is not available with the California Emissions Package). A 3-speed transmission is standard. TorqueFlite automatic transmission is available at extra cost. You get front disc brakes, sway bars at front and rear, heavy-duty suspension, Electronic Ignition System and all-welded Unibody construction. In fact, the basic good stuff you'd expect from Chrysler Corporation engineering.

You also get a quiet interior . . . and a choice of five radios—from AM to AM/FM multiplex stereo with 8-track tape decks—to make that quiet all the more enjoyable.



The Fury Family of Radios includes push-button models in AM, AM/FM with 8-track stereo tape, AM/FM stereo, AM/FM Multiplex with stereo. All stereo sets come equipped with 2 front and 2 rear speaker setups. In view of the major noise isolation engineering that goes into every 1975 Fury, you can imagine the quality of sound available. Fury Power Assists provide a number of useful services. For '75, you can order power door locks that make it so much easier to lock all doors. Power windows permit you to control fresh air flow as you

would like it when you're at the wheel.

Power steering is a wonderful aid in handling your Fury in parking situations. And Fury's optional power front disc brakes offer sure, smooth braking regardless of terrain and with minimum pedal pressure—something you'll appreciate in crowded traffic.

Timely economy measures:

Let's also talk about Fury's optional fuel-savers for '75, You'll be surprised how quickly **Auto Speed Control** can pay for itself. A simple push-button control permits you to set the speed you desire. **Auto Speed Control** will then hold that speed until you brake below the mph you've programmed.

Same for Fury's **Fuel Pacer System.** This new accessory is installed in the fender-mounted direction signal.

When it lights up, you're being asked to take it easier on the gas pedal . . . and thereby easier on gas consumption. Plymouth engineers have also figured out fuel-saving **rear axle** ratios. The lower the ratio number, the more economy you can expect.

Fury's Wheel and Tire story is interesting for '75, too. Two styles of road wheels, the rallye type and the "mag" design, are available on models taking the 14" wheel size. A new, bladed-style wheel is molded in super-tough polyurethane, then mated to the steel 15" rim. This material is easily cleaned and rust-free. And it looks great, too.



System which employs bars that twist, rather than coils which compress...a different way to provide a comfortable, quiet and balanced ride over all road surfaces. You won't find torsion bars on any of Fury's domestic competition.

Remember, too, that a Fury is engineered to last. Fury's 7-step

dip-and-spray process inhibits rust, provides a wonderful basis for the wide range of gleaming acrylic enamels you can choose for '75. Each Fury body also is sprayed with sound deadeners which along with strategically placed jute pads give you a degree of quiet you can appreciate only by driving the Fury of your choice.


This sort of dependability is also built into the Fury's electrical components. Our Electronic Ignition System delivers up to 35% more starting voltage than conventional systems for surer starts in bad weather. Plug life should be good for 30,000 miles, almost twice the mileage formerly recommended for a change to new plugs when the engine is operated with unleaded fuel. Such advanced thinking is also revealed in the solid state fidelity of the Fury's many optional radio models.

You'll also want to remember that

our smooth but rugged TorqueFlite transmission permits efficient conversion of power to the rear wheels. And that means, naturally, efficient use of today's expensive fuel.


