

No question about Monaco's being a luxury car. One glance tells you. Gleaming new grille. Long, sloping hood. Taut rear deck. Massive bumpers, front and rear. And for 1970, a wider rear stance for greater stability. Monaco offers an even smoother ride than ever before. Torsion-Quiet Ride, available on hardtop and sedan models, brings a new concept of silence to the moderately priced field. This suspension system reduces road noise and vibration in the interior of the car. (A more detailed explanation can be found in specifications.)

The interior of the '70 Monaco is spacious, with special attention given to even the smallest detail. The instrument panel has simulated walnut in the instrument and switch areas and on the horizontal moulding that runs across the thickly padded dash. Deep-pile carpeting is offered in a wide choice of colors. Optional 50-50 splitbench seat (see opposite page) for the convenience of driver and passenger alike. And if you were limited to a one-word description of Monaco's ride, you'd probably say, "Quiet."

A car as good-looking as this just has to have a luxury ride and performance to go with it. Monaco for '70 does. Look under that long, lean hood. Check that big, 383-cubic-inch V8 engine. It's ready and eager to obey. You just give the orders. Monaco's handling is superb. Threads through heavy traffic almost effortlessly. And out on the highway, Monaco holds the road as if it owned it. The four-door above shows the optional cornering lights. They let you see ahead into a turn. An optional vinyl roof is available in four colors plus Gator Grain on hardtops and three colors on sedans.

Monaco's taillights fill the entire bumper opening. They are well protected from accidental mishaps.

Air conditioning for even more driving comfort is available as an option with or without automatic temperature control. The latter keeps the inside temperature always constant, no matter what the outside temperature may be.

Like the look and feel of luxury? Come in. Relax. This is a '70 Dodge Monaco.



Rallye Suspension with sway bar. And a "man about town" should have music wherever he goes. Ask for the AM radio with the eight-track stereo-tape player. Want more? How about trunk carpeting and a spare-tire cover? Now all Monaco needs is your name on it. That's a do-it-yourself project.


ELECTRICAL SYSTEM

Battery: 12-volt, 6-cell, 59-amp-hr, standard with 383-cu.-in. engine. 70-amp-hr, standard with 440-cu.-in. engine and optional with the 383. Alternator: 37-amp, standard. (46-amp, standard with Airtemp air conditioning and optional on Monaco models not so equipped.)

Hydraulic, servo-contact, self-energizing, self-adjusting. Bonded linings. Dual Braking System. Parking brake is foot-pedal-operated, with hand-released lever and mechanically actuating shoes on each rear wheel.

MONACO ENGINES

The standard Monaco engine is the 383-cu.-in. 2-bbl. V8 using regular fuel to produce 290 hp at 4400 rpm. Optional is the 440-cu.-in. 4-bbl. V8 engine (requires premium fuel; 350 hp at 4400 rpm).



NEW TORSION-QUIET RIDE

All 1970 Dodge Monaco hardtops and sedans are equipped with the new Torsion-Quiet Ride which retains all of Monaco's handling characteristics, but further reduces road and engine noise in the passenger compartment. Noise reduction is achieved by using a new type of rubber isolator in a number of key suspension locations: at the front, in the rear, and along the steering gear. In addition, a new front "stub frame" further isolates noise from the rest of Monaco's body.
