

Road ready to go the distance.

The 1983 Turismo offers up-front value for the driver who appreciates intelligent engineering, impressive mileage, and the driving excitement of open pavement.

For 1983 you'll find standard halogen headlamps for a longer and whiter beam, and a maintenance-free battery for trouble-free starts. For more driving convenience there's Rallye instrumentation, including clock, trip odometer, and tachometer. Passenger side vanity mirror is standard. So too are attractive exterior black moldings that surround the entire passenger compartment.

Turismo's roadability and agility come from its standard transverse-mounted 17-liter four-cylinder engine,* precise rack-and-pinion steering, improved power-assisted front disc brakes with larger front calipers and metallic-type pads, and self-adjusting rear drum brakes. With standard 17-liter engine† and four-speed manual transaxle, the Turismo has a rating of **37** EPA EST MPG; 50 estimated highway! That's impressive in any automotive class, but when you add interior room and comfort and a truly sport-minded exterior you have one very special small specialty car.

The 1983 Turismo 2.2 packs even more punch than the regular Turismo. It sets you up with an exciting mix of standard features that emphasize this car's performance potential. The 2.2 model includes such standard items as a simulated hood scoop, performance exhaust system, unique tape graphics, rear liftgate spoiler, a sport suspension system, and low-profile steel-belted radial black sidewall tires. The Turismo 2.2 looks as good as it handles. It features all the standards you'll find on the popular Turismo. But there is a difference.


When the red light turns to green, you'll discover the difference. It's called high performance capability. Instant acceleration...and exhilaration...are due in part to the new standard five-speed manual overdrive transaxle working in concert with the performance-oriented 2.2-liter four-cylinder engine. This engine has an increased compression ratio of 9.0:1 for 1983, and a quicker opening throttle linkage for improved "performance feel." A major benefit of these improvements is a 12 percent increase in horsepower for 1983.

So, if you're big on performance and good looks but like to spend wisely, this is one road show you won't want to miss. You'll be pleased to know that the Turismo 2.2 is a standout performer that comes...and goes...without the high price of admission.




Turismo 2.2 standard interior with optional free-standing armrest, shown in Red

That's what Chrysler's uncompromising commitment to quality is all about... more quality per car and more value for your dollar.

Take for example the 2.2-liter engine (available on Turismo, standard on Turismo 2.2). It was especially



designed for front-wheel drive. For 1983 it offers a number of improvements in horsepower and torque, including a redesigned intake manifold, and redesigned intake and exhaust ports.

Inside and out, Turismo's sophisticated design is the achievement of computer-age


technology...with built-in efficiencies geared toward practicality and value. Styling is thoroughly studied and analyzed. Not just make-it-look-nice styling, but aerodynamically tested styling that uses the flow of the air to hold the car to the road while maximizing engine power and fuel efficiency.

Turismos are assembled in one of the world's most modern high-tech assembly plants. Computer-controlled automated welders are used to ensure uniform quality.



Turismo's unitized body is fabricated with galvanized sheet metal panels in many critical areas, one of the best known methods of corrosion protection, and zincmetal panels in sensitive areas, as well as a seven-step dip-and-spray process. Cars are checked constantly during assembly to make sure parts fit and systems work.

For 1983, improvements have been made in Turismo's power braking system. New self-adjusting rear brakes with new brake drums and master



cylinder with power booster are standard. Additional brake shoe lining area has been added for longer wear life.

On the appearance side, new Crystal Coat paint colors have been added in 1983 for better protection and good looks.

The result is a car of remarkable quality, yet economical to own and operate. Size up the new Plymouth Turismo or Turismo 2.2 yourself. Check the quality and value. We know you'll find it high because we've already checked it—many times.

Here's the distinctive and exciting front-wheel drive Plymouth Scamp for 1983. Bold and sleek at the same time, and as peppy as it looks.

With its responsive 2.2-liter engine and optional five-speed manual transaxle (standard on Scamp GT), you'll find it only skimps at the pump. The Scamp is rated at **28** EPA EST MPG,* 47 estimated highway.

And whether you choose the Plymouth Scamp or the sporty Scamp GT you'll be able to take a lot of fun with you in its spacious cargo area. Some other pluses are standard power brakes, rack-and-pinion steering, radial black sidewall tires mounted on 13-inch Rallye wheels (14-inch Rallye wheels and raised black letter tires are standard on Scamp GT), and tinted glass on all windows.

Scamp's "with it" good looks are enhanced by black belt moldings, color-keyed cargo area flange moldings, and bright protective wheel opening and sill moldings.

And when it comes to standard equipment, Scamp doesn't skimp with its quartz clock, trip odometer, front and rear bumper protective rub strips, halogen headlamps, and maintenance-free battery.

Scamp even has a tethered gas cap so you don't have to worry about leaving it behind on those rare occasions you "filler up" at the pump.

The 1983 Plymouth Scamp takes you where the action is in a style uniquely its own. And it allows you to take almost anything with you, thanks to its 1145-pound payload* capacity—large enough to haul anything from scuba diving gear to a load of firewood.

Neat little beauty

Scamp GT is Plymouth's "fun machine." One that can be used for work or play but with the emphasis definitely on the play. Scamp GT lets you do both.

A quick glance tells you it has sporty good looks. Its Scamp GT hood scoop says it. Its 14-inch road Rallye wheels say it. And its sleek aerodynamic styling that uses airflow to hold it on the road while maximizing engine power and fuel efficiency says it all.

Out on the road Scamp GT moves smoothly along, its 2.2-liter four-cylinder engine performing economically. Rack-and-pinion steering offers good response on every curve and corner. Independent Iso-Strut front suspension with coil springs and leaf spring rear suspension provide a smooth, enjoyable ride.

Inside Scamp GT the impression is even more sporty. Cloth-and-vinyl high-back bucket seats with integral head restraints and reclining seatbacks are standard. So is a full front console with integral shift lever to accommodate the standard five-speed overdrive manual transaxle.

And if you intend to use your Scamp GT for hauling camping gear and equipment, you'll be happy to know that Scamp has a load-sensing brake system that provides automatic braking balance front-to-rear regardless of its load conditions.

Quality and value are Chrysler's commitment to Plymouth Scamp. And it is reflected throughout this distinctively handsome vehicle.


It's obvious in Scamp GT's driving compartment where a sport steering wheel frames the easy-to-read instrument cluster (shown at left above). Clock, tachometer, and trip odometer are all standard.

It's obvious in the comfort and support provided by the Plymouth Scamp interiors. Shown at left center are Scamp's standard all-vinyl low-back bucket seats in Beige. Shown at bottom left are Scamp GT's no-charge optional all-vinyl high-back bucket seats in Black. Shown at bottom right are Scamp's optional cloth-and-vinyl low-back bucket seats with reclining seatbacks in Beige.

And above all, Scamp is a sporty vehicle that's big on high technology. The commitment to quality runs very deep. A few of Scamp's many engineering advantages are:

- One-piece tailgate features double-wall construction for extra protection
