

Avenger ES has a driver's seat that remembers and available door locks that forgive if you forget.


The lumbar-adjustable,

The double platinum-tipped spark plugs in Avenger ES are designed to last for 60,000 miles.




Driver and front-passenger airbags are standard, as are high-strength steel beams in the doors.

Open the Avenger ES trunk, and 13.1 cubic feet of room are yours. As is an ingenious system of nets to keep cargo in place. And, you can lock the fold-down split-back seats, and trunk lid, to secure valuables.





A built-in thirty-second delay function allows you to operate Avenger's optional power windows even after you've turned off the ignition switch. That means you should never have to restart the car to raise the windows. And once you've put the windows up, an ingenious system of seals helps shut out wind noise.



For better visibility, a brilliant little detail called "waterguard edge molding" helps keep water off the side windows, by channeling it up the edge of the windshield, and over the top.



Front-wheel drive adds to the sense of control and confidence you get in the driver's seat.

Avenger's independent double-wishbone suspension system is among the most sophisticated designs in the world. It allows for excellent handling without sacrificing ride, and helps isolate the passenger cabin from excessive road noise and vibration. Because this suspension's advanced geometry helps keep the tires perpendicular to the road, traction is enhanced while cornering.
