Prowler is an unabashed tribute to an original American art form. It is the result of a bold raid on the corporate parts bins by a buccaneering Plymouth Platform Team that was intrigued with the term "factory hot rod." That's where the resemblance ends. Prowler is an engineering tour de force. It's a rare blending of youthful exuberance, mature judgement, and technical excellence that envelopes a refreshing new way for driving enthusiasts to get their enjoys. Prowler is quick, like all hot rods should be, because its LHS-derived, 3.5-liter high-output 24-valve SOHC V6 has been hopped up to a crisply responsive 200-plus horsepower via a classic hot rod bolt-on, stainless steel exhaust manifolds, among other upgrades. The power-to-weight ratio traces to aluminum coachwork, which Plymouth will be bringing to production years before similar two-seaters exhibited in recent shows by European makers like Audi, BMW, and Lotus. Prowler's balanced handling reflects an "Indy"-style independent front suspension with inboard-mounted coil-over shocks; and an independent rear-wheel drive transaxle

like the Porsches 928S and 968. Prowler is fully convertible, too. Meaning roll-up windows, and a super-sealing top so svelte that

this roadster looks like a chopped three-window coupe when it's raised. Hmm... do Gran Turismos prowl drive-ins?
